You will provide training to other staff around the mental and physical health and behaviour support needs of clients in order to enable the effective implementation of such plans.

You will provide individual and group therapeutic intervention as required with the aim of reducing the frequency, severity and intensity of challenging behaviours.

This position is based in Porirua, however it covers the central region from Tawa to Palmerston North so there will be occasional travel required.
